00:00 And for me, this tribunal is an extension of the Rwandan justice because without ICTR, those people would not have even been tried because nobody, even now, they, they don't want to give to the Rwandese the possibility to try their own people. We, we are trying their own people, the Rwandese.

00:23 So for me, this tribunal is an extension of justice, of the hands of justice of the Rwandese. That is our role. I'm Italian. The only thing that I can do is just let me do it, but it's up to them to make a judgment. It's not up to me. Me, I just try to do what, what I can.
